Attendance

Minutes of AGM 2020

Fees were reduced due to being online from the normal €80/70 (+10/-10) to €50/40 (+10/-10).

The following were elected to the committee and filled their offices: John Loughran, Karthick Thoppe (Treasurer), Mark Allidine (Facebook).

The following either resigned or did not participate for various reasons: Áine Doran (Vetting, replaced by Frank, Junior Officer, vacant), Fred Harte (Ratings, replaced by John), Dan Aldridge and Bláithín (Prizes, replaced by Karthick), Marco Mancosu (Coaching organiser, replaced by John).

During the season the following were co-opted to fill vacant offices: Frank Sullivan (Vetting), Andrew Conneely (2nd team captain).

Full minutes are included in the yearbook for the 2020/21 season under Yearbook on the website.

Minutes were approved without amendment. We discussed some possible venues for the club for next season in case the school do not allow us in or delay in allowing us in. These included the Art Room in the Mills, the GAA club and other places.

Progress since Foundation

Now near the end of our 10th season. Founded on 2/10/2012. Prior to COVID we had three teams in Leinster leagues. This season we had two in the Hibernian Online League and one in the over-the-board William Brennan Cup.

Membership and Attendance

30 members (24 last season, 45 in 2019/20 season). 3 members were inactive.

14 Adults (10 last season, 24 in 2019/20 season) and 16 juniors (14 last season, 21 in 2019/20) including 7 girls and 9 boys. So roughly $\frac{3}{4}$ of pre-Covid numbers, an encouraging recovery.

A turnover of 8 new members is similar to previous years.

Average attendance on Tuesday nights was 13 (18 last season, 26 in 2019/20), so a big drop in attendance.

Team Competitions

The Leinster leagues ended in March 2020 and are due to resume in September 2021.

In Spring 2022 Skerries entered two teams of 4 in the Hibernian Online Chess League.

The Knockout Cups were played in April 2022 over the board. We entered one team of 6. Apart from this all our games were played online this season.

Unplayed competitions included the Novices league, the Mick Germaine Cup and the Dublin Finals of the Community Games.

Practice is external tournaments and in league games is essential to promote the development of all players especially promising players including juniors. Playing games rated by the ICU also puts players in line for selection for international teams at all age groups, otherwise they are invisible to selectors and ineligible.

Andrew echoed this advice and encouraged everyone to take part in external tournaments.

Tournament Controller's Report - Internal tournaments - John

Results of all tournaments played are on our website under the Tournaments menu, and prize winners are listed under Prizes below. We held the Autumn and Turkey Tournaments, the latter concurrent with the Skerries Community Games before Christmas. Starting in January the Club Championships (which ran alongside the Hibernian Online Chess League and some novelty events. Recently we finished the Piece Handicap Open. All tournament events were online. Unlike last season there were no links with other clubs or online games apart from a brief visit by some guests.

Team reports: First team: Hibernian Online Winter League, Division 1 - John

We entered two teams in the Hibernian Online league, our first team to do as well as possible and the second to gain experience with a lot of team rotation. As you can see our first team finished second in Division 1, which is probably the highest placing Skerries has ever achieved in an open team competition.

Team reports: William Brennan Cup - John

We entered one 6-player team in the first over-the-board team competition held since Covid halted the Leinster Leagues in March 2020. The knockout cups normally follow the leagues in the early summer.

Our team was in Group A and again our priority was to blood as many players as possible and to give everyone at least one taste of what was for many their first competitive game against another club. As only the first two teams qualified for the knockout stages we did not. Despite our inclusive policy we did fairly well and many new players got great experience including juniors, some of whom scored their first wins.

Top scorers were Joe Dunne who lost his first game on time in a good position, but kept his morale up to win his next two games. Owen Johnston got two good results to get 1.5 / 2. Seven new players played their first game representing Skerries which will count towards their first ICU rating. Both matches were played in the Skerries Amalgamated Bridge Club to whom we are very grateful for facilitating us.

Teams for next season

We expect to field 2 – 3 teams in the Leinster Leagues this coming season, one in the Knockout Cups, in the Dublin Community Games and other competitions.

Junior Officer's Report – John Loughran

Community Games

Only the Skerries competition was held. Results under Tournaments on website.

Garda Vetting – Frank Sullivan

Any club undertaking activities which allows regular contact or access to children/vulnerable persons is required by law to ensure that all its members are Garda Vetted. This includes adult playing members, teen members and parent supervisors (one of whom is the parent/guardian of a junior member).

During 2021/22, although the club has operated primarily online, **the Garda vetting requirements remain mandatory.** The process is almost complete for current members, with some outstanding.

All new members / parent supervisors joining the club are required to complete a Vetting Invitation Form which can be downloaded from the Skerries Chess Club website. The completed hard copy form, **along with two forms of valid ID** – a photo ID and proof of current address – should be provided, preferably in person, to the Garda Vetting Officer of the Club for verification. Where it is not possible to verify in person other methods of verifying identification may include a video call (e.g. Zoom) where the person, along with their photo ID and proof of current address are visible to the Vetting officer. Once the vetting officer is satisfied that these are verified, a copy or photo of the ID and proof of address may then be sent online to the Vetting Officer.

The Vetting Officer keeps a hard copy of the completed Vetting form and IDs and inputs the information to the online Garda Vetting Bureau. Typically within 10 days the new member/parent supervisor will receive an email from the Garda Vetting Bureau. This includes an online link to the vetting application form which needs to be completed within 3 weeks. If this is not completed within this timeframe the application is cancelled and the process has to start again. It is essential that vetting invitation is completed as soon as possible. Within several weeks a disclosure is then sent to the Skerries Chess Club Vetting Officer. This is kept on file. **Vetting is valid for three years.** There is a fee of €5 per vetting which the club pays. If any member would like to see a copy of their vetting disclosure please contact the Vetting Officer – see Contacts on website.

John adds: All but four members have started their vetting applications to date, by submitting the correct documents. The committee have decided that membership will be suspended for those members who have not submitted the necessary documents within three weeks of their first visit to the club, until they do so. Some applications have been held up due to a difficulty with the vetting mechanisms within the Fingal Volunteer Centre, and we are working to remedy that.

LCU GDPR form: John Loughran

All members who play in the Leinster leagues must sign a form to say that they consent to their details being stored by the LCU and ICU for the purposes of running leagues and tournaments. Most have signed. This will resume next season I presume. The club requires similar consent on becoming a member.

Webmaster's report: John Loughran

www.skerrieschess.com was set up in November 2012 with over 85 000 visits to date (5 000 last year, less than usual). Hosting costs around €30 annually. If we carry out our plan to introduce an online database and increase security this may increase by about €30. The tournament controller John Loughran uploaded the pairings and results for each tournament weekly. The ratings officer Fred Harte retired in the Autumn so John updates the ratings on the website weekly, usually within a day or two. Members can review all their results this season. We also have a facebook page: f: skerrieschess, monitored by Mark Allidine and a WhatsApp group, which we used very little this year, monitored by Karthick Thoppe. The Parents' rota on the website will resume next season. Child Protection and Safety are on the website.

Coaching

We did some coaching on Zoom for juniors and adults, starting at 7 pm with short 20 to 30-minute sessions. Thanks to those who contributed: John, Martín, Mark, Krishiv, Andrew and others? This could also be repeated and could include more contributors, I hope.

There is a link to a coaching video on YouTube by Mark on the Coaching page, as well as other valuable resources and advice from different coaches.

Rating

When Fred retired John took over rating our results weekly as before. On the ratings page if you click on [Skerries Ratings Online.htm](#) you can see your full rating history, all games won, drawn and lost against all opponents, a really interesting resource.

Treasurer's Report – Karthick Thoppe, John Loughran

Fees

Normally fees are €80 for seniors, €70 for juniors/students, with €10 euro off for each additional family member, and a €10 euro supplement for those wishing to play in the Leinster leagues.

Last season due to COVID we reduced fees to €50 for seniors, €40 for juniors/students, with €10 euro off for each additional family member, and a €10 euro supplement for those wishing to play in the Leinster leagues.

The committee met on Saturday 21 May and decided to revert to normal fees for the coming season to reflect the likelihood of returning to over-the-board chess.

This is despite the fact that rent may well exceed what we paid in the past, due to the uncertain location of our venue. We feel that the club can afford to subsidise the cost of rent for one season without increasing fees beyond the normal pre-Covid levels. (80/70, -10/+10)

AGM of Leinster Chess Union

The LCU may hold their AGM in July. Two delegates from each club may attend and vote.

Volunteer to Help Run the Club

We need your help to run the club for the benefit of junior and senior members alike. The club is run by volunteers and without your help we cannot continue. If all the work is left to a few members then it becomes too much. If it is shared it is easy. All members and one parent of each junior member are expected to help in some way, either on the committee, on the supervision rota or in other ways.

Most roles require no expertise other than to be organised, keep records and communicate with the chairperson. For other roles training will be provided in using spreadsheets, pairing programs etc. Most roles take an average of 30 minutes per week, though it varies from week to week depending on the role. Below is a list of roles with a brief description and the estimated time required.

Treasurer 1 - Record fees paid, owed, money spent - Excel/similar - 25 mins

Treasurer 2 - Arrange public liability insurance - Phone skills - 3-6 hours once off

Club captain - Decide makeup of teams - Record players strengths, Excel - 15 mins

Team Captain 1st - Choose players, make team sheets, record results - Enter results online - 30 mins
